

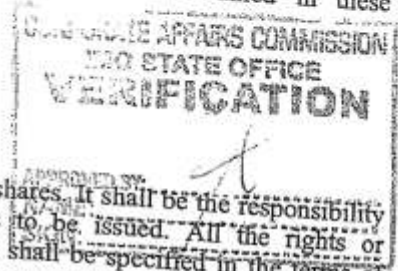

1. INTERPRETATION

- a. In this regulations, "the Act" means the Companies and Allied Matters Act.
- b. Unless the content otherwise requires, words or expressions contained in these regulations bear the same meaning as in the Act.

2. CLASS OF SHARES

The company may from time to time issue classes of shares. It shall be the responsibility of the directors to determine the classes of shares to be issued. All the rights or restrictions attached to each particular class of shares shall be specified in the terms of issue but such rights may at any time be varied in accordance with the provisions of section 141 of the Act.



3. RESTRICTIONS ON TRANSFER OF SHARES

The directors may in their absolute discretion and without giving any reason, refuse to register any transfer of any share, whether or not it is fully paid share.



4. PRE-EMPTIVE RIGHTS OF SHAREHOLDERS OF THE COMPANY

The company shall not allot any new or unissued shares unless the same are offered in the first instance to all the shareholders or to all the shareholders of the class or classes being issued in proportion as nearly as may be to their existing holdings. The offer to existing shareholders shall be by notice specifying the number of shares to which the offer, if which the shareholder is entitled to subscribe and limiting a time, not being less than twenty-eight days after the service of the notice, after the expiration of which the offer, not accepted, will be deemed to be declined. On the receipt of an intimations from the shareholder that he declines to accept the shares offered or after the expiration of the stipulated time, as the case may be, the board of directors may, subject to the terms of any resolution of the company, dispose of the shares at a price not less than that specified in the offer, in such manner as they think most beneficial to the company. **5. COMMISSIONS AND BROKERAGE**

The company may exercise the powers of paying commissions conferred by section 131 of the Act, provided that the rate per cent or the amount of the commission paid or agreed to be paid shall be disclosed in the manner required by the said section. Such commission may be satisfied by the payment of cash or the allotment of fully or partly paid shares or partly in one way and partly in the other. The company may also on any issue of shares pay such brokerage as may be lawful.

**6. ALTERATION OF CAPITAL**

**7. MEETINGS**

The annual general meeting shall be held at such time and place as the director shall appoint. The chairman, if any, of the board of directors shall preside as chairman at every general meeting of the company, or if there is no such chairman, or if he is not present within thirty minutes after the time appointed for the holding of the meeting or if he is unwilling to act, the director present shall elect one of their number to be chairman at the meeting. If at any meeting no director is willing to act as chairman or if no director is present within thirty minutes after the time appointed for the holding of the meeting, the members present shall choose one of their number to be chairman of the meeting.

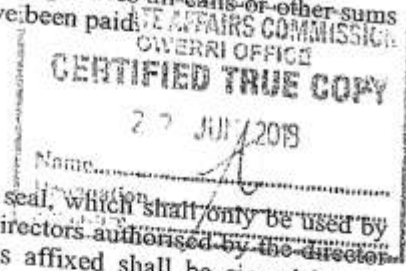

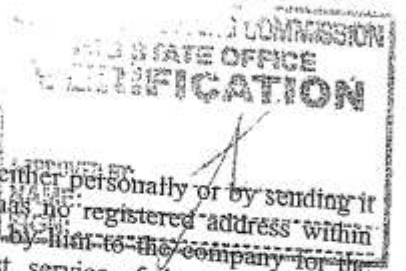
**8. VOTING**

In view of this concept, PROJOX CONSTRUCTION LTD consciously and deliberately operates Health, Safety and Environment Management System integrated basically on technical requirements of the following international standards:

- BS 8800:1996-Guide to occupational Health and Safety Management.
- OSHAS +8001: 1999 OCCUPATIONAL Health and Safety Management Specifications.

- BSEN ISO 14001: 2000 Environmental Management System.

PROJOX CONSTRUCTION LTD is committed to proving and encouraging positive involvement in improved environmental performance, most especially as it affects work community affairs, ensuring that procedures are followed, vetting environmental provisions of clients and complying with all legal requirements and relevant environmental regulations and policies. Ensuring that established methods and procedures are maintained for effective measuring, evacuations, and, monitoring on a regular basis the key characteristics of business operations and activities affecting the goals,

### HSE MANAGEMENT TEAM:

### HSE AUDIT PLAN:

Frequent and regular inspections of machinery, plant equipment, tools, materials, work site structures and other facilities involved on any project will be made especially to eliminate hazards and to assure that all conditions are in accordance with applicable standard requirements. Essentially, any unsafe or possible hazardous situations will be reported and immediate positive steps taken to comply fully with the appropriate HSE standard.

The HSE Management Team shall be directly responsible for all level of audit programs. The Team will inspect all equipment and facilities using a standard inspection check list. The audit findings shall be documented and distributed to all action parties for effective implementation.



## QUALITY ASSURANCE MANAGEMENT SYSTEM:

PROJOX CONSTRUCTION LTD is totally committed to quality in the performance of its work. It is the intent of the management to provide quality service to clients in a manner, which complies with contractual and legislated requirements, in the most effective and cost effective manner.

The quality assurance policy of the management of the company is that all personnel, in all job functions, must perform their duties in accordance with the requirements of the ISO 19003 Quality Management System and are committed to the quality objectives of PROJOX CONSTRUCTION LTD in their everyday work activities. To this end, corporately, management is well positioned to provide resources to establish, maintain and document an effective and economical quality management system, developed and implemented as an integral part of other fundamental to the internal and external controls of company, shall be implemented at all times. Quality is enhanced by working in a systematic manner to formalized processes and procedures designed to eliminate the occurrences of deficiencies and to promote uniformity of working practices irrespective of contract requirements.

## BASIC HSE RULES:

- Horse play of any kind is not allowed
- Use of safe guards provided
- Work at safe speed – running is not allowed
- Help new employees learn safe work habits – ensure HSE induction training.
- Reporting to work under the influence of intoxicating beverages or drug will grounds for immediate discharge.
- Never start a job unless you know how to do the job. Consider safe operation first and seek for help when in doubt.
- Wear right cloths for the job.
- Compressed air must never be used to clean a work area.
- Work from approved scaffolds, and or ladders only, not boards, boxes etc.
- Report defective tools and equipment
- Know the location of fire fighting appliances, extinguishers and hydrant, hoses and know how they operate
- Report the use of fire extinguishers to your supervisor as possible so that it can be refilled or replaced.
- Report any hazardous condition to your supervisor when working.
- Never leave hoses, wire or cables on ladders, stairs, scaffolds or your presence.
- Make sure ladders are in good condition, firmly placed and properly secured
- Store flammable materials in designated areas. No smoking, burning or welding within 5-20 meters of this area.
- Keep hands and feet clear of pinch points when handling materials.
- Never leave running power equipment unattended.

## ORGANIZATION RESPONSIBILITIES /POLICY IMPLEMENTATION /MANAGEMENT ROLE:

The responsibility for ensuring implementation of the health, safety, environmental and security rests directly upon the management of PROJOX CONSTRUCTION LTD; management is poised to shoulder this responsibility. Responsibilities will be assigned to supervisors with the necessary backing in terms of funds and commensurate authority. Safety Officers will also be appointed and will be present at every work site. The Safety Officer is advised and ensures that all work activities are conducted in a safe manner.



- Allocation of sufficient resources to provide and maintain conditions and places of work, as far as it is reasonably practicably safe and healthy.
- Ensure that all machinery, plants and equipments are in good working order, appropriate tool for the job will be made available and safe.
- Provide where necessary, approved personal protective equipment and clothing and to ensure that employees understand their proper usage.
- Ensure that adequate instructions are given to employees on all aspects of their work, especially those hazards to health.
- Review operations and work methods from time to time in order to incorporate where necessary, changes in statutory obligations and technologies.

#### FOREMEN/ SUPERVISORS' RESPONSIBILITIES:

The immediate responsibility for health and safety at work rests with the line supervisors. They are primarily concerned with preventing accidents, which result in injuries to persons and damage to company property.

It is the responsibility of the supervisor to give clear instructions to his men. He will ensure that every employee under him complies with the instructions and work practice stipulate for the job assigned. Necessary personal protective equipment must be warned before workers are allowed to such job areas that requires precaution.

#### GENERAL GUIDELINES:

- Vehicles in use must be inspected at the start of each shift to make sure that the listed parts are in good operating condition and safe, if failure could happen. Parts to be checked are: all breaks, including service brakes, hand brakes, trailer break connections, tires, horn, steering mechanism, seat belts, coupling device, operating controls and all safety devices. Where lights reflectors, windshield wipers, defrosters or fire extinguishers are necessary, these are to be inspected with the same regularity.
- Any vehicular defects found in the previous inspections are to be used.
- Winch blocks used on trucks or tractors must be equipped with a safety bridle on the hook.
- Only licensed and trained drivers may operate motorized vehicles.
- Drivers and operators are responsible for the safety of all on their vehicles.
- They must comply with all safety regulations, laws, ordinances, and speed restrictions.
- Any accident, whether involving personnel injury or material or property damage, must be reported to supervisors at once.
- The use of alcohol or other intoxication elements by any driver or operator is completely forbidden.
- Drives must always slow as soon as they see children on sidewalk or roadways. Any school bus, laws must be strictly obeyed.



- Always drive as close to the right side of the road as is safe.
- Always put truck into a low gear before crossing rail tracks and look both ways.
- Stop and look in both directions before entering a highway from smaller roads.
- When approaching a blind curve, slow and sound the horn.
- Always signal properly when slowing or turning.
- Trucks in a convoy are always to be a minimum of 300 feet apart.
- When starting down steep hill with trucks loaded with men or materials, shift gears to the position which optimizes vehicles.
- Always pull to the side of the road before stopping a vehicle. If a breakdown occurs at night, keep lights on to warn other drivers. If lights fail, use other appropriate warning signal in stopping or parking any vehicle on or near a highway, always obey local ordinances.
- Any vehicle or equipment having an obstructed rear view must not be operated. Alarm must loud enough to be heard over the area noise level OR there is a signal man to guide the operator.
- The rear view mirror is to be kept, intact, used, and intended drivers must take care to obstruct the normal flow of and to make it easy for on-coming traffic to pass.

#### TRANSPORTING STAFF:

Almost all transportation accidents are preventable. Whether as drivers, operators or passengers, all employees must follow the rules for safety and use common sense at all time.

- Only employees or official visitors are permitted on company vehicles or equipment.
- Drivers must strictly follow all local traffic rules, laws and regulations, with particular attention to posted or practical speed limits.

#### ROLE OF SAFETY OFFICER:

The safety officer will advise management and supervisors on safety matters as may be necessitated by the job to be executed. He will carry out the following duties:

- Give pep talk-or early morning briefing to workers before the day's job begins.
- Ensure that workers wear necessary personal protective equipment.
- Conduct unsafely meetings and implement all related action points as they affect company's operations.
- Ensure that the right tools are being used for the job.
- All equipment in services must be in good working conditions.
- Ensure that functioning First Aid Box is on site and all employees are made to obtain treatment no matter how minor the injury may be.
- Investigate any accident may occur at worksite.



#### SAFETY POLICY:

It is the policy of the company to carry out its activities in such manner that no fatality or serious injuries or damage to property arise there from.

Every necessary step shall be taken to safe guide all that work for us including third parties.

Positive attitude to safety shall be rewarded and negative ones frowned upon. Detailed Safe Procedures must be put in place and site management is held accountable for its implementation on site.

In order to ensure an evitable safety performance, the following strategies will be adopted.

- The continuous identification of all accident causes.
- The control of accident causes
- The minimization of accident losses.

#### ALCOHOL AND DRUG POLICY:

Any employee found to be under the influence of Alcohol or in possession of, or under the influence of any hard drug such as marijuana, Heroin, Hashish, or other illegal or controlled substance while working or residing on any job site including property and equipment under the control of any of such shall have his /her employment terminated immediately. In the case of such illegal or unauthorized items being discovered to be in the possession of an employee by the company, such items and or materials shall be reported and released to the appropriate law enforcement agencies not withstanding and penalty from the company.

#### SEAT BELT POLICY:

ATPROJOX CONSTRUCTION LTD, we recognized the fact that safety seat belt enhance the chance of survival and reduces the risk of injuries in vehicle accidents. As such, it is mandatory as a matter of policy for every worker, especially on company's business to always fasten his belt. All light and heavy-duty vehicles trucks, tractors, etc must seat belt fitted in them and must be worn by driver's mate and operators always. All line management personnel are to ensure compliance with this policy. Serious penalty awaits defaulters of this policy.

#### SECURITY POLICY:

Our company always ensures that all facilities where staff work and resides have sound security plan in place. Improve the security awareness level of both staff and sub contractors associated with operators. We uphold security information disseminates to all staff in offices and logistics base station.

#### NIGHT DRIVING POLICY:

Unless on an emergency PROJOX CONSTRUCTION LTD, forbids night driving in all her operations. It should be clear to all drivers that approval for such night driving must come from the management (line / staff) or client representative.



#### FORWARD:

It is our policy to provide and maintain a safe working environment, for our employees, who are our most valued assets, the safety of our employees our utmost priority and all safety equipment must be provided before any job is carried out.

All staff of PROJOX CONSTRUCTION LTD shall be medically fit. We shall maintain an insurance against any liability that may result in case of any personal suffering and occupational diseases or any impairment to health resulting from our operations. The company's retained clinic shall handle all routine medical and emergency cases.

As an essential part of the overall company's management, PROJOX CONSTRUCTION LTD takes responsibility of security of all personnel, clients' Representatives and third parties in all our work sites and premises. In carrying out our operations, PROJOX CONSTRUCTION LTD shall plan and execute it in such a manner as to eliminate adverse effects or impacts on the environment. Our operations shall be essentially environmental friendly. PROJOX CONSTRUCTION LTD shall identify with the needs and aspirations of her clients and the host communities in the execution of its operation. We shall liaise with client's host community (s) relevant government departments and others to ensure safe and peaceful work environment. Harmonious relationship shall be maintained with clients and community (s). Where there are conflicts, peaceful dialogue shall be employed to resolved areas of disagreements.

#### WORK PERMIT:

Many of the tasks that we shall perform are covered by various types of work permit e.g. the permit to work system with complimentary certificates for hot work; excavation, electrical work, confined spaces work, restricted area work etc. thus;

- Check with client representative whether a permit is required for any of the planned work routine and non routine works.
- Read the work permit carefully and comply with all the work and safety procedure requirements.
- Review / validate the work permit when expired.
- Sign off the permit when work is completed and the area made safe.

#### SITE CONTINGENCY AND / EVALUATION PLANS AND PROCEDURES:

The following plans and procedures are established to enable effective handling of emergency and evacuation situation that are likely to have potential for injury, stoppage of work, damage to property or environment.

- A team shall be set up for emergency situation. This shall comprise the site project engineer and the site safety officer.
- Fire extinguishers and well equipped First Aid box shall be provided at work site.
- Before commencement of work at any site, a muster point shall be identified, designated and all workers notified of its purpose and instructed on its use by the site safety officer. Where affordable, a standby ambulance shall also be available on work site.



Specific procedures relevant to work injuries and fire outbreaks shall be written and conspicuously displayed at strategic positions at work site for drill and application.

#### WASTE DISPOSAL SYSTEMS:

Wastes constitute environment nuisance if not properly collected, handle and disposed. Wastes shall therefore be collected, and handled and disposed off in an environmentally friendly manner as not to cause injury or damage to plants, animals and the environment (the soil, water and air).

Industrial construction waste shall be collected in bins marked accordingly in remote locations.

Bio-degradable wastes shall be disposed off in pits and backfilled. Non degradable waste (but combustible ones) shall be incinerated with proper precautions taken not to cause air pollution. Non-degradable and non-combustible wastes shall be collected, crate and conveyed for disposal at government approved disposal site. In all however, proper precautions shall be taken to avoid discharge of pollutants in the air, land or water. Dumping of wastes in creeks, rivers, and other water course is not allowed.

#### QUALITY ASSURANCE AND QUALITY CONTROL POLICY STATEMENT:

The management of PROJOX CONSTRUCTION LTD very well understands that to achieve accelerated business growth and to capture, maintain a good share of our business market, there is the need to completely satisfy both our internal and external customers.

To achieve this objective the company has put in place well structured step by step procedures in the analysis of problems and execution of daily tasks.

The management has, as a matter of policy, decided to entrench the culture of quality assurance and control into the various strata of the organization to be accomplished as follows:

- To employ the services of a professional management consultant to train all categories of our staff on the principles and practices of the universally proven tool of management i.e. TOTAL QUALITY MANAGEMENT (TQM) in our approach to business.
- To produce, as an offspring of the training program and in conjuncture with the .t consultant, a well structured quality assurance manual for use in the company's operations.
- To set up quality improvement and monitoring work groups to identify and analyze quality improvement opportunities as well as proffer workable solutions to enhance quality improvement.
- To maintain a continuous feedback system from our clients as part of our quality improvement efforts.
- To ensure that the right tools and equipment are available for all our service jobs and effecting timely replacement whenever the need arises.
- By maintaining well-motivated and technically experienced staff.

Considering the primary role which high quality consciousness is to play in our organization, the management has accorded the pursuance and implementation of the above measures a top priority rating. The management of the



total quality process, as contained in our Health, Safety, Environment, and Security policy, shall be considered as an integral part of our daily operations.

#### GENERAL QUALITY ASSURANCE, (GOA), CONTROL PROCEDURES QUALITY (CPQ):

The management reviews this quality to ensure its continuous suitability, and effectiveness. Management review is carried out by nominated senior personnel, independent of the system element under review. The results of all such reviews are recorded detailing the findings, conclusions and any recommendation before submitting to management for implementation.

#### ENGINEERING AUDITS:

- Engineering Execution Audit
- Procurement Execution Audit
- Outside Major Equipment Vendor Audits
- Technical Safety Audit
- Project Completion Audit

#### PROCUREMENT:

Procurement instructions, procedures and approvals will be established to assure a systematic process. Procurement documents developed during the requisition and purchase order process will be controlled, review and approved in accordance with a quality minded procedure.

The procurement Agent under the direction of the Project Manager will be responsible for the project procurement organization and the implementation of procedures related to procurement functions. The procurement plan and procedures will ensure the following: That proper planning is done to establish all steps and interfaces necessary to ensure that all technical and commercial goals are met.

- That the approved vendor's list is formalized as early as possible.
- That requisitions received from the engineering department have been reviewed and properly approved.
- That manufacturer's representative s or supplies that are being considered have been properly evaluated for:
  - o History of providing quality products and services.
- Economics soundness.
  - o Quality Assurance Systems consistent with the overall project requirements.
  - o Technical ability as it applies to the specific product in question
- That inquiries, when used, are consistent and as complete as possible
  - o When issued.
- That the bid evaluation process follows the established procedure for review and approvals for technical and commercial completeness. This will include client approval when required.



The Project Quality Assurance Officer will authorize and follow up on any corrective action required. Project Quality Assurance and his organization will identify the equipment and materials that require inspection in vendor facilities and incorporate into the outside inspection program. The amount of outside inspection of the vendor, reviews, audit etc. will be determined by the nature of the items, its relation to performance and any contractual requirements.

#### CONSTRUCTION:

The Project Construction Superintendent will be responsible for the overall field construction activity including the fieldwork aspects of the Project Quality Assurance Program. Refer to the General Execution Plan and the construction.

Executive for further discussion of the construction is the superintendent's duties.

The project Quality Assurance for construction will be under the direction of the Project Quality Assurance Officer will be developed by the Project Assurance Officer. All plans, organization and staffing will be submitted to the Project Quality Assurance Manager for approval.

The Project Quality Assurance Program for construction will provide instructions procedures, controls, verification, reviews and audits consistent in the overall project. The program will ensure the following.

- That the contract requirements are documented in usual form and distributed to all personnel involved in activities that effect quality.
- That the field construction organization is accepted and staffed with qualified personnel.
- Those instructions, procedures, code and other data that will control the field construction work are prepared, approved, issued and adhered to in the areas to be covered.
- Working instructions and procedures.
- Special process.

Audit of the construction activities will be conducted by the Field Quality Assurance Officer. These audits will include the following:-

- Construction Execution Plan Audit
- Spot Audits Quality Related Activities.

The audit report will be documented with any deviation or nonconformance item clearly identified. The report will be issued in the same manner as the review reports discussed above.

The shop fabrication activities when used will be reviewed and audited in a similar fashion as the field construction work. These quality assurance activities will be handled by quality assurance organization. The existing shop quality control manual and quality control program will be utilized as it applies to current specifications, any additional requirement, if need be, both for our shop and for field construction will be added for this project in the form of a supplement.



## PRE-COMMISSIONING, START-UP AND INITIAL OPERATIONS:

The operation superintendent will be responsible for the overall commissioning, start-up and initial operations including the quality assurance aspect of these work activities. He will report directly to the Project Manager. Further description of his duties can be found in the general executive plan.

The operation superintendent under the direction and approval of the project manager will develop and implement the various plans, work. All such procedure will include the quality requirement of the project. He will also be responsible for the organization and staffing for project but will also be reviewed and approved by the project manager. The pre-commissioning or mechanical completion will be an overlapping activity between construction and commissioning. The operations superintendent and certain of his organization will be involved in the commissioning to the extent necessary to verify readiness for commissioning prior to start-up. The operations superintendent's organization will be referred to as startup and operations team. This team will provide continuity to the commissioning, start-up. The operations superintendent and certain of his organization up and initial operations. This will be accomplished having the same key or supervisory team personnel working on each phase consecutively. The operation superintendent will be responsible for all interface function, documentation and reporting activities. He will establish the training programs for the start-up and the operation team as well as any other that may be required for the client's operation personnel. Review within the start-up and the operation group will be held by the operations superintendent to ensure that his work plan is being implemented in accordance with the project manager. The field activity reviews to be held by the operation manager will include the following.

Commissioning, start-up and initial operation reviews.

- Work Plan, Instruction and Controlling Document Review
- Client Requirement Review.
- Start-up and initial operation review.
- Spot reviews of the Start-up and initial operation activity.

The quality assurance officer and his organization will monitor the reviews held by the Operations Manager. They will document and report on each review summarizing any problems or deviations from the approved plant and other project requirements. The report will be issued to the operations Superintendent, Project Manager and the Project Quality Assurance Officer. The Quality Assurance Officer will authorize and follow up on any corrective action needed.



In addition, the Quality Assurance Officer will hold audits of the commissioning, start-up and initial operation program to ensure that all project requirements are being met.

#### WORK IN PROGRESS CONTROL PROCEDURES; OUR RESPONSIBILITY:

- It is our responsibility to ensure that all items are fabricated in accordance with the technical requirements of the contract drawing and specification. In this respect, we shall provide all necessary quality assurance and quality control activities to meet such requirements. The Client Site Team will carry out quality control surveillance to ensure that these activities are performed.
- After completion of the project, there shall be certification of completion, starting compliance with contract specifications together with the final as-built documentation for submission to the CLIENT.
- Fabrication, welding, painting, and related inspection and testing procedures,
- Welders and NDE operator's qualification and certificates.
- Document and procedure.

#### QUALITY CONTROL

PROJOX CONSTRUCTION LTD shall submit comprehensive procedures to every CLIENT for review and approval as it concerns our activities with them before we proceed.

- Where mechanical equipment is to be installed or pre-commissioning work undertaken, working procedures must be developed on the basis of supplier's information.
- These procedures shall be adhered to, throughout the project.
- PROJOX CONSTRUCTION LTD shall maintain a register of these procedures, which shall detail functions limiting factors. Our QC shall ensure that this is done correctly.
- Our receipt and issues inspection procedure will ensure that:
  - Correct materials and equipment without any apparent damages are received and primed.
  - Materials and equipment are properly protected / stored.
  - They are properly marked related to purchase orders and material certificates.
  - Traceability of material certificates against material used in the fabrication shall cover.
    - o Material verification to be carried out.
    - o Material certificate summary and material certificates to be compiled.
- Fabrication Construction will ensure that;
  - o Material identification numbers are transferred when required by THE CLIENT.
  - o Members and welded joints are uniquely identified when required by THE CLIENT.
  - o Records are maintained
  - o Surplus and salvage materials are identified and stored properly.
  - o The site Team is to be notified and the material returned to THE CLIENT at the earliest opportunity.



Our QC shall monitor each stage of the material control system.

- QC personnel shall review and check the completeness, accuracy and traceability of all fabrication documents and submit to THE CLIENT Site Team on a regular basis for acceptance/approval.

- That sufficient records and lists are maintained and issued to report and track progress of each general activity. These records will include numbering and progress of items such as equipment, instruments, requisition, drawings, correspondence and approvals.

That each discipline has the latest codes, reference materials, calculation procedures, software or other tools

to satisfactorily perform the required work. All comments, questions, on conformance items resulting from reviews, audits and audits are documented and followed to proper final resolution.

- The Engineering will be attended, monitored and documented by the Quality Assurance Organization to ensure compliance. Any departure from the quality plan or requirements will be immediately reported to the Project Manager and Project Quality Assurance Officer will authorize and follow up on any corrective action required.

- Indication of inspection status.
- The effective communication personnel involved in Quality Control activities and these involved in construction and Material Control, concerning any concessions and / or corrective actions found to be necessary and their implication on the quality system.
- Qualification and identification of operators.
- Qualification of work procedures (e.g. welding)
- Control, calibration and maintenance of inspection and test equipment.
- Recording of results from inspections test.

12.0 CORRECTION OF NON CONFORMITIES:

All non-conformities and deviation from drawings and specifications, as well as any non-conformities of material, welding, painting etc. shall be reported and recorded by the contractor' QA/QC or site Team. Non-conformities shall be corrected or disposed off.

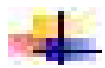
